EACH ROAD LEADS TO WROCLAW :)

OK, maybe almost each road ☺ but luckily for you there are many possibilities from Warsaw. After leaving the airport in Warsaw the best way to get to Wrocław is to take train. Firstly you should take bus no 175 directly to the central train station. Usually it takes about 30 minutes. But be aware that due to traffic jams your trip can be a little bit longer.

The trip to Wrocław (exact name of the station is Wrocław Główny) lasts over 5-6 hours. Everything depends on which type of train you will take. The fastest ones but also the most expensive are Intercity and Express (over 100 PLN). While choosing "pospieszny" which is a train that stops in most medium size cities you will spend travelling over 6 hours but you will pay only half of the Intercity/ Express price.

You can buy a ticket at the train station just before your train will leave. Maybe not two minutes before because of long queues which unfortunately occur quite often:(
